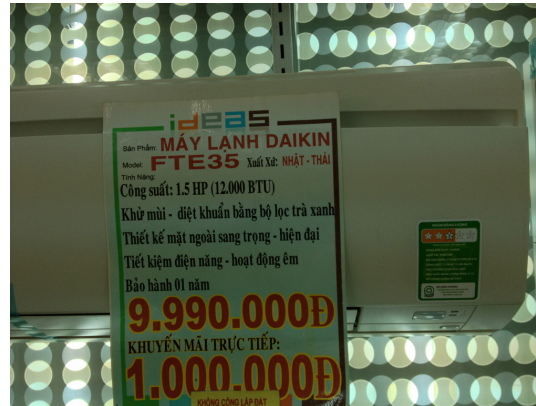

---

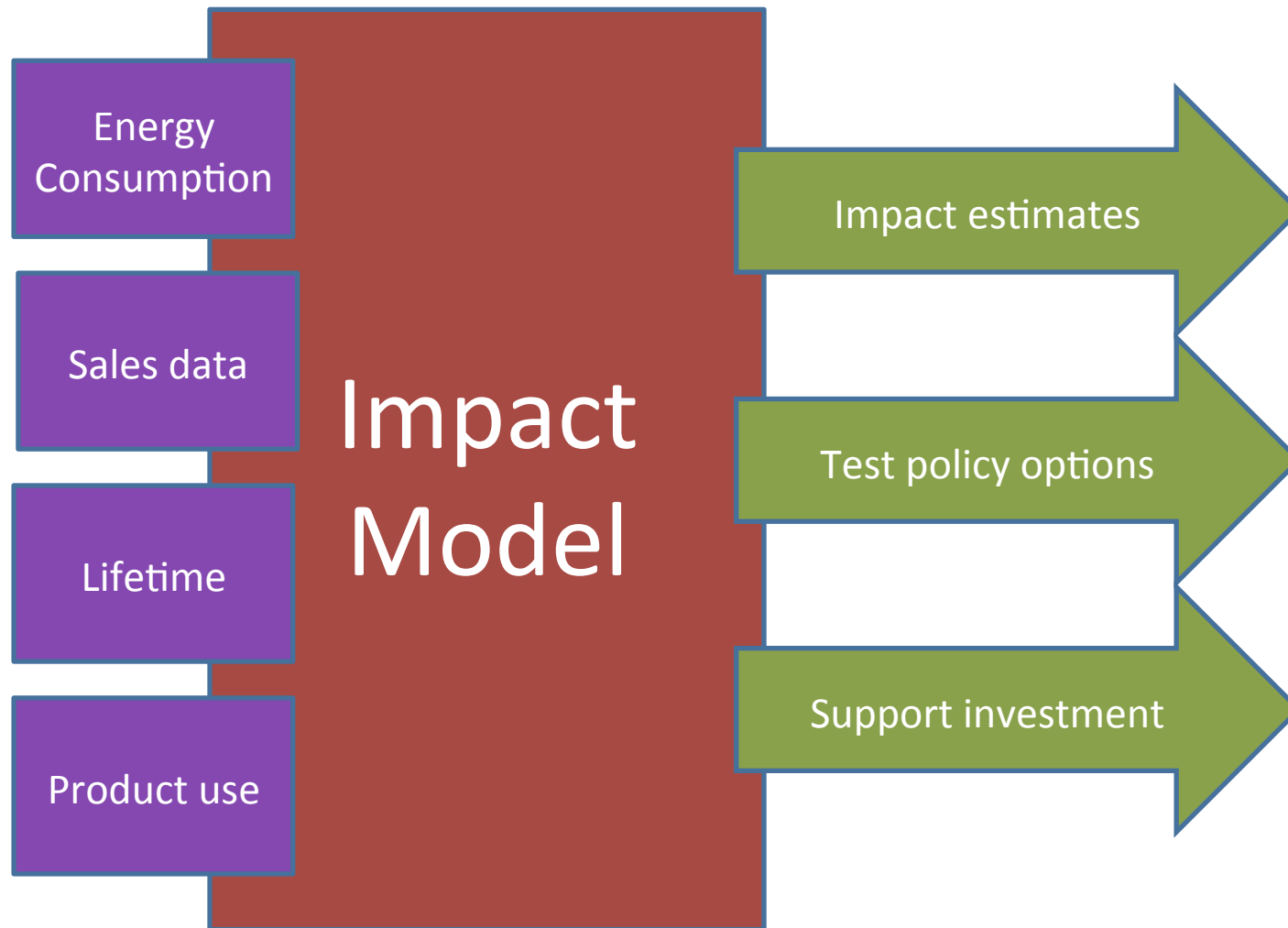
- Ministry of Industry and Trade wanted to build capacity to:
  - Forecast energy savings
  - Evaluate impact of MEPS and energy labels
  - Utilise data to refine and develop policy
- Program designed with this in mind:
  - Registration system – sales mix
  - Market studies – appliance use and attribution
  - Label display survey - compliance

- Training program:
  - Modelling energy consumption and savings compared to baseline
  - Estimating the extent to which energy savings can be attributed to program
  - Principles of evaluation
  - Collecting and utilising data
